Tender for a consultant to deliver Save the World Club's projects in local communities

Environmental creative arts charity, Save the World Club (SWC) wishes to engage a consultant to deliver its local projects and related activities in Kingston-upon-Thames. The consultant will work alongside SWC's staff, volunteer and trustee team to manage the day to day delivery of two key projects as well as helping to generate new project ideas and funding working closely with the Director.

The tasks include:

- Project managing the delivery of two new projects that sit under SWC's well-being and youth strands working alongside SWC staff and volunteers. The projects will involve working with local residents including young people, members of the community, representatives of partner organisations in the borough and Kingston Council officers.
- Undertaking outreach in the borough to build and maintain key relationships and partnerships with public, voluntary and private sector organisations and representing the charity at relevant meetings and other events as appropriate
- Producing relevant materials, resources and tools to support effective delivery of activities as well as outputs from project activities
- Organising and/or attending meetings and/or other events in connection with the projects and to promote the charity's work and share outcomes and outputs
- Identifying new ideas for projects based on local need and funding sources/opportunities, and working up proposals.

The consultant would be expected to have experience in project delivery in local communities including supporting children and young people's participation and working with a wide range of stakeholders. They would not necessarily be expected to have a background in the environment or arts sectors. Knowledge and/or experience of working in the health or children's/youth sectors could be an advantage.

The contract will be managed by Jo Butcher, SWC Director. It is intended to run for 7 months from the start of September 2013 (sooner if possible). The contract is for around 60 days at £100 a day.

The consultant should be able to work from their home or office, though it is expected that in order to deliver activities a significant part of their time would be spent either at Save the World Club's office or attending meetings in Kingston.

SWC's legacy includes 50 mosaic art installations made for communities by communities, many of which can be seen in locations across Kingston. We will also build on our successful Green Police Environmental Stewardship programme to establish a young Green Police presence in Kingston and hopefully in the future, across London.
